2. Leadership Development trainings

John F. Kennedy, in his campaign speech said, "It is time for a new generation of leadership." As Kennedy desired to see young leaders rising up to take the lead, it is also Alliance Women Ministries' desire to see young women stepping up to take on leadership roles in all levels, the local women's groups, on the district level and National level. As we move forward, I strongly believe that it is through young leaders that will be able to lead, reach and impact their own generation. However, in order for Alliance Women Ministries to have strong and capable women to lead in all levels, we need to invest in the lives of these young women by developing and equipping them. For this reason, the leadership development training was developed and held in the following places:

- a. Merced, CA (March 16-17, 2018). We had 226 in attendance.
- b. Wausau, WI (April 20-21, 2018). There were 178 attendees.
- c. Pontiac, MI (August 10-11, 2018). We had 44 attendees.
- d. Auburn, GA (September 21-22, 2018). There were 173 in attendance.

We want to thank the leaders from the churches mentioned above for your love and support. Thank you for your willingness to open up your churches and be a host site for these trainings. We will not be able to repay you for the kindness you have shown AWM but we pray that the God who lacks nothing will bless you thousand folds.

3. Third Culture Kids (TCKs)

What a blessing it is that we have many local women's groups willing to pour out their love in supporting/sponsoring our TCKs through prayers, gifts and finances. This year we have four TCKs, Iris Her (daughter of Rev. and Mrs. Nkaaj Ceeb Her); Selah Thao and Abraham Thao (daughter and son of Mr. & Mrs. Tou Lee Thao); and Tobias Cha (son of Mr. & Mrs. Jackson Cha). 4. 40 Years Celebration/Annual Conference

What a great year for Alliance Women Ministries to collaborate with Hmong District in celebrating its 40th year in St. Paul, MN. We see how

much God has blessed Hmong District, and especially Alliance Women Ministries throughout the celebration. Alliance Women Ministries has come a long way, and it was truly a blessing to witness His grace for women one generation after another.

Alliance Women Ministries was truly blessed to be given the opportunity to taste and experience His grace through the many events, such as the Celebration banquet. We praise and thank God that we had about 650+ attendees at the banquet on Saturday evening, May 26, 2018. Through God's grace through the years to the women, Alliance Women Ministries humbly presented a check in the amount of \$54,265.30 to Hmong District to start a scholarship for missions for young women in honor of Ruth Andrianoff.

In addition to the Celebration, Alliance Women Ministries also held its Annual Conference at the St. Paul River Centre May 29-31, 2018. We had a total of 180 (delegates: 135 and corresponding: 45) women attended the conference.

Apart from the workshops, AWM also had its annual election of new leaders. The result of the election is as follows:

Due to resignations from the treasurer, N. Xf. Leej Koob Xyooj, and Media, N. Tswv Koob Vaaj, the Executive Leadership Team appointed N. Tswv Txos Thoj as the interim Treasurer and N. Yaosoua Moua as the Media to fill the unexpired term, which is 1 year.

5. Budget

Alliance Women Ministries' budget for 2018 is \$121,300.00 (\$40,000.00 carried over from 2017 towards the Ruth Andrianoff scholarship). The total revenue for 2018 is \$156,179.00 (excess of \$34,879.00) and the total expense is \$153,827.00. This leaves a net income of \$2,352.00 for the year 2018.
